Summary of the project: What is the purpose of the project? How many participants are expected? Where will the participants be from? How will the project strengthen cooperation with the 3i partner institutions? Is there any previous cooperation between the participants? What are the expected results? This project aims to strengthen informal collaborations between members of research teams in Lille and Ghent, around a corpus of comics available at the University of Ghent. It aims to contribute to the history of transnational cultural circulations and cultural transfers (processes of translation and adaptation, the evolution of privileged genres, or the effects of imitation between magazines). It also plans to question the discourses on comics, thanks to a unique corpus of fanzines (magazines produced by fans), which offer an unprecedented inventory of the ways of considering and thinking about comics in the 1960s, 1970s and 1980s, when this cultural form was going through a process of legitimation. A part of this team has already led a research project, supported by the University of Lille, that resulted in the book (A Suivre). Archives d'une revue culte (Tours, PUFR, 2018). This book was edited by Sylvain Lesage and Gert Meesters, and had chapters by Maaheen Ahmed, Benoît Glaude and Benoît Crucifix. This project would allow two sets of teams (Gert Meesters and Sylvain Lesage in Lille, Maahen Ahmed, Benoît Crucifix, Benoît Glaude, Donna Pursall, Margot Renard, Eva Van der Wiele in Gent) that are geographically close and complementary in terms of research (history, literature, cultural studies, linguistics) to strengthen their collaboration and build new research projects. We expect two main results from this mobility







	 the development of a methodological know-how that will allow us to undertake future joint projects, in a more ambitious perspective (submission of cross-border / European projects). the creation of a Lille-Ghent comic strip research cluster, federating for the years to come initiatives that have long been dispersed. The project therefore has a strong potential for the development of a research team.
